Before we grant a computer to a person with a disability through our NHU Computer Literacy and Grant Program, we offer them the opportunity to invest in their computer grant either by volunteering at our office or they can give a small membership fee. Individuals are also encouraged to share resources or experiences that have been helpful to them, to offer solutions to others who may experience common problems.

In return, they receive more than just tools for themselves. They become people helping other people. Our members, if they are homebound, are finding a way out of isolation, many are going to school, volunteering for other organizations, helping in their community, or developing their talents as artists and entrepreneurs.
