- Provide home access to a computer via our Computer Literacy & Access Program

ADVANCE EMPLOYMENT

- Provide hands-on training and experience in IT and Office Administration via temporary work experiences and internships
- Develop and promote materials aimed at:
 - Educating individuals with disabilities on workplace environments and behaviors
 - Educating employers on the benefits of hiring individuals with disabilities
- Identify professional mentors and create a network of employers committed to inclusive recruiting and hiring practices

We have trained and offered career guidance to dozens of individuals with disabilities in the Office Administration and Information Technology fields in preparation for a future career

We have supported the building of wheelchair accessible cabins in Wisconsin's State Parks

We have had the great fortune of receiving well over \$200,000 worth of expertise from dozens of dedicated volunteers

THE STORY OF NHU

New Horizons Un-Limited (NHU) was founded by Arthur Miller in December 1994. Upon attending a community meeting to discuss controversy over residential housing for individuals with disabilities, Art observed, that yet again, a key ingredient was missing from this meeting - representation from the disability community.

It was at this point that he realized the importance of enabling individuals with disabilities to take a more active role in determining their own destiny. He believed that if individuals with disabilities were given a means to communicate with one another, and most importantly, a means to access information and resources concerning the issues that affect them, they might be able to make a positive change in their own and others' lives.

Thus began New Horizons Un-Limited. What started as a small website, with just a few visitors a month, has grown into a service organization, serving hundreds of thousands of people impacted by disability annually via our internationally accessed website and local community initiatives.

Today we look forward to many more years of advocating on behalf of our community members with disabilities!
